NOVA ACADEMY OF COSMETOLOGY DRESS CODE POLICY

Purpose:

Maintaining a professional appearance is essential for success in the beauty industry. This dress code policy outlines the standards of attire expected from students at Nova Academy of Cosmetology.

General Dress Code:

Attire:

All students are required to wear all-black clothing. The only exception is for accessories, which may be in a different color.

Cosmetology and Esthiology Students: A school apron or smock provided in the student kit must be worn during clinic floor hours. The smock or apron should not be torn, stained, or altered.

Advanced Practice Esthetic Students: Must wear black scrubs, with underclothing allowed in different colors. Professional shoes are mandatory, and Crocs or similar shoes are not permitted.

Identification:

4. **Identification Badges:** As required by State Law, identification badges must be worn as issued during all clocked hours to identify students and staff to guests.

Footwear:

5. **Professional Footwear:** Footwear must be professional, and athletic shoes are not acceptable, with the exception of Advanced Practice Esthetics.

Apparel Guidelines:

6. **Bottoms:** Professional black skirts or slacks are permitted; denim is not allowed. Skirts should be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee.

7. **Tops:** Shirts should be professional and black only. No hoods, halter-tops, tube tops, sleeveless, or bare midriff tops are allowed.

8. **Headwear:** No hats are permitted.

9. **Undergarments:** Undergarments must be worn and should not be visible at any time.

We are professionals in the industry and must look professional.

10. **Dress Code Enforcement:** Students not dressed professionally, as reasonably determined by Nova Academy of Cosmetology, will be dismissed to change. Learning Leader's discretion will prevail.

Electronic Devices:

11. **Prohibited Items:** Students are prohibited from wearing or carrying beepers, cell phones, or other electronic devices during instructional hours.

12. **Cell Phone Usage:** Cell phones may be used only during breaks and lunch and must not disrupt the learning environment.

This dress code policy is subject to periodic review and may be updated as needed. Students are expected to adhere to these guidelines to create a professional and conducive learning environment. Non-compliance may result in disciplinary action.
